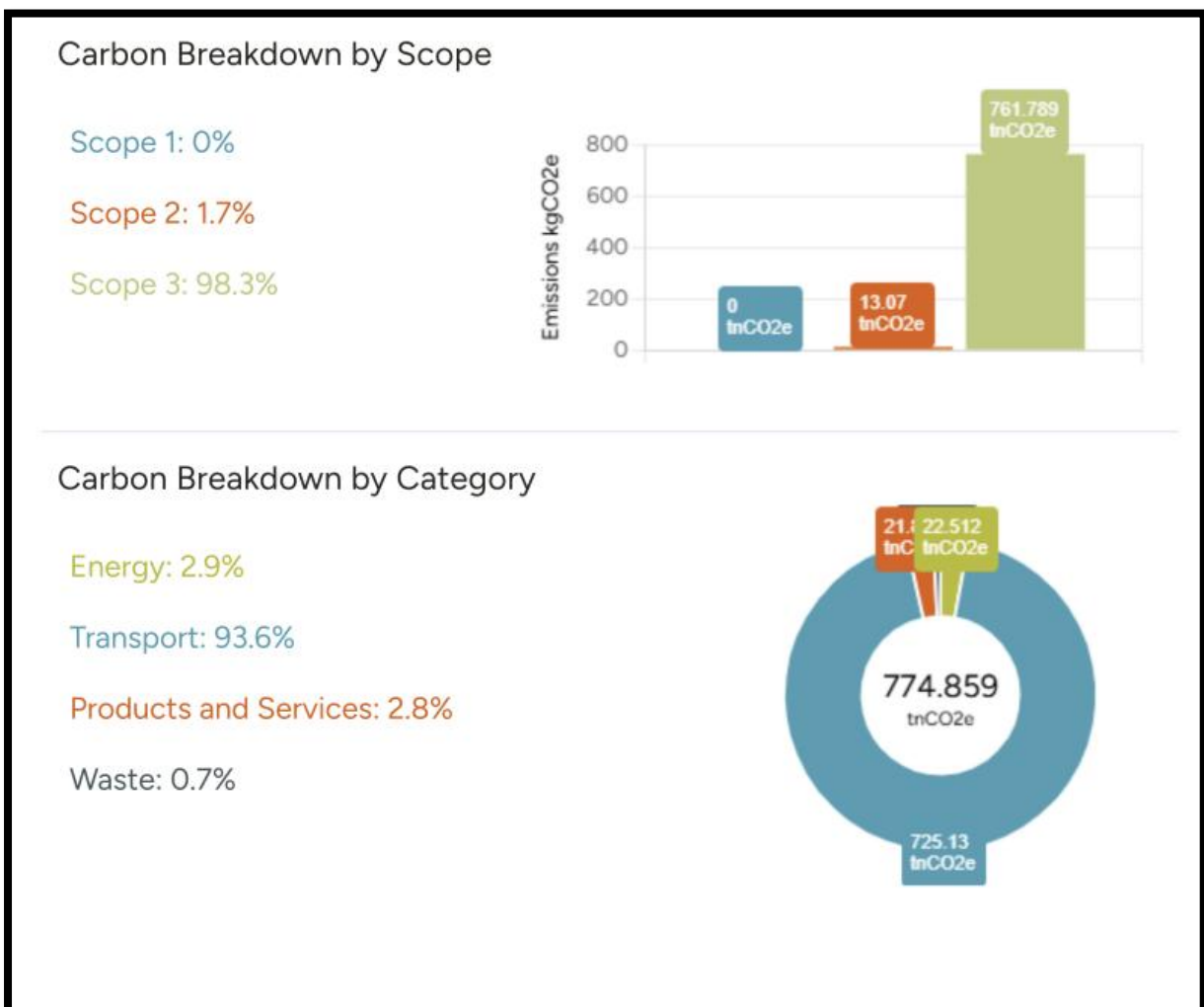
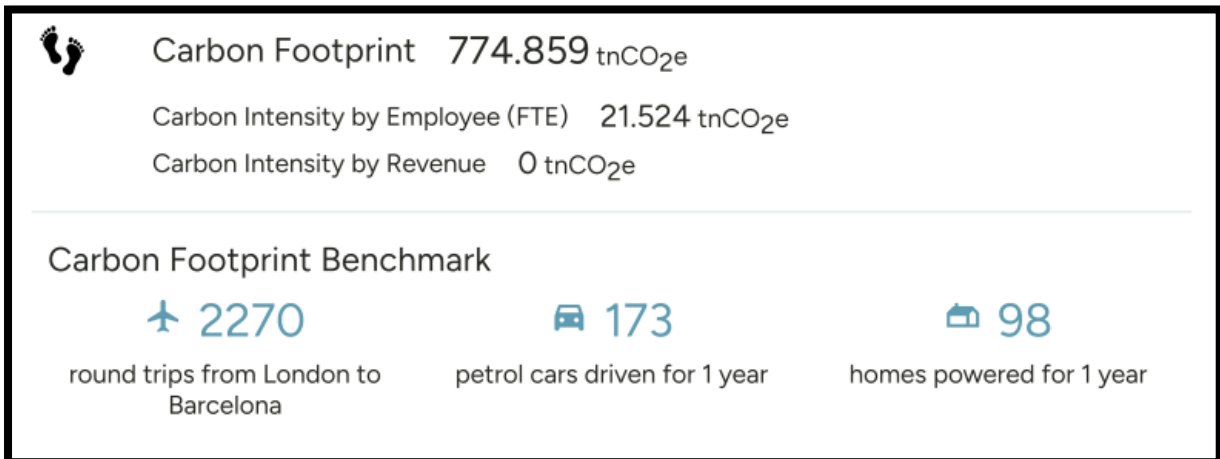

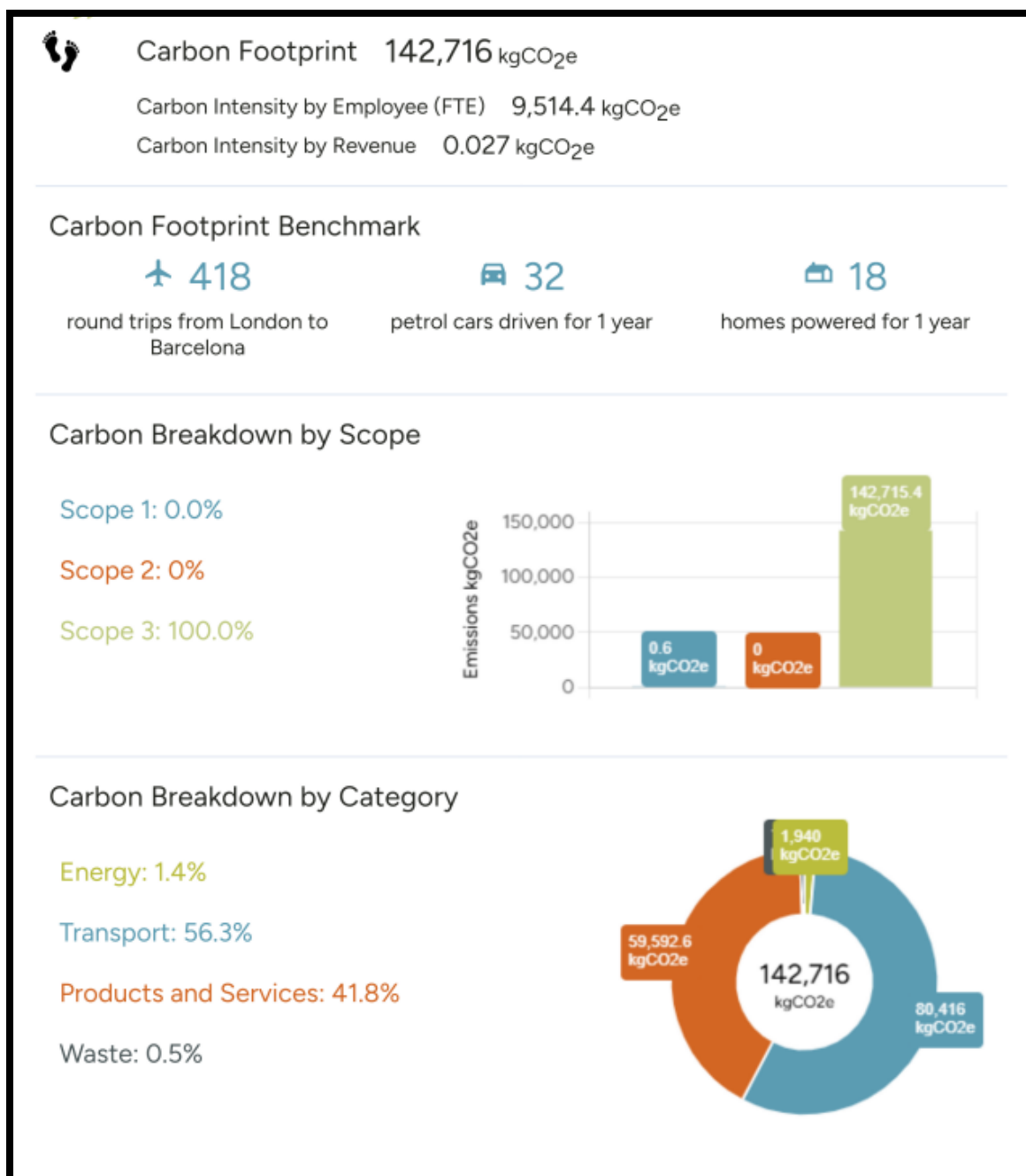
## Baseline year emissions 2021 for Circularity First Group

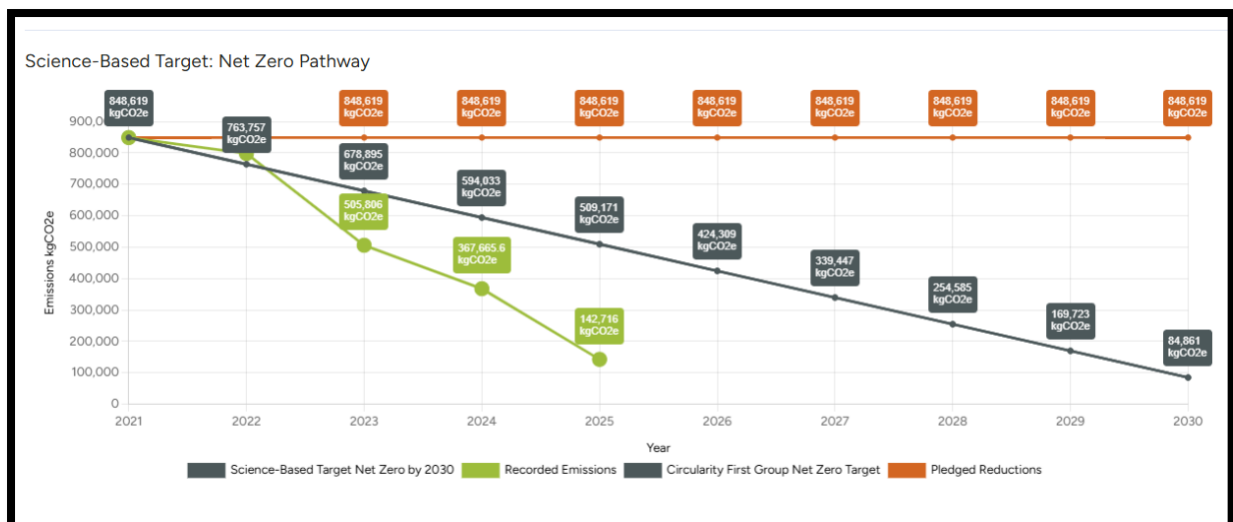

- We continue to work with key stakeholders in our supply chain to find ways to reduce carbon emissions, specifically in logistics and packaging.
- Our strategic initiative Keep Kit in Region (KKIR) is specifically designed to reduce carbon emissions and cost.
- Our business model is centred around extending the life of technology and normalising the use of non-new technology. This directly aligns with findings from the IPCC#6 Synthesis Report that promotes environmental sustainability by promoting sustainable production and consumption and an improvement in environmental quality in support of the 25-year environment plan of the UK Government. The use of non-new technology directly aligns with the UK Government Greening ICT and Digital Services Strategy and with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal Number 12.
- Closure of our all our warehouses with a move to 3PL partners handing our logistics
- We have moved to a fully remote business which has reduced business travel, and shifted emissions heavy logistics activity outside our direct operational boundary
